MOTION

for Peace and National Reconciliation in Libya

The African Parliamentary Union, meeting at its 38th Conference in Bissau on 5 and 6 December 2015,

Concerned by the unstable political and economic situation in Libya,

Desirous of contributing to the reconciliation of all Libyans and to put their country back on the path to peace and development,

Noting the strides made recently in the area of promoting political dialogue among Libyans under the auspices of the United Nations,

- 1. *Invites* all political players to engage in constructive dialogue to advance the democratic transition process, set up public institutions and preserve unity, sovereignty and territorial integrity in Libya.
- 2. *Calls upon* all countries, in particular, Libya's neighbours, to pursue their efforts to promote dialogue among Libyans, so as to arrive at a national consensus and engage the country on the path to stability and reconstruction of their country.
- 3. *Urges* countries to provide the necessary protection for Libyan investments for the reconstruction of the country.
- 4. *Supports* efforts aimed at promoting dialogue and national reconciliation in Libya.
- 5. *Brings* its support to Libya in its struggle against terrorism.
